HOUSE BILL **436**

AN ACT establishing a commission to solicit reports and testimony regarding unidentified anomalous phenomena in the state.

ANALYSIS

This bill establishes a commission to actively solicit reports and testimony regarding instances of unidentified anomalous phenomena within the skies and territory of the state of New Hampshire for the purposes of their collection and transmittance to the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA).

1 submitted testimony and evidence shall be maintained in the files of the commission and subject to
2 91-A, unless such testimony and evidence is in violation of the framework of the 2024 National
3 Defense Authorization Act. The NARA maintain and catalog such reports; therefore, a state
4 database need not be authorized. A simple file of offered testimony and submitted evidence shall
5 suffice.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
