HB 269 removes the requirement that there be a Saturday session of the supervisors of the checklist prior to Election Day, provided that the session occurs as required by statute. In the past, the Saturday requirement to hold a session has caused issues when a severe weather event coincides with that day, resulting in checklist supervisors being forced to hold the session during severe weather to fulfill the statutory requirements. The committee believes removing "Saturday" from the statute would give checklist supervisors flexibility without sacrificing fairness or access. For these reasons, the Election Law and Municipal Affairs Committee recommends that HB 269 Ought to pass.
