HB 222 would repeal the requirement for a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between chartered public schools and local school districts regarding how students with disabilities receive special education services. The bill is intended to reduce administrative burdens while preserving existing special education oversight and collaboration. The committee voted to re-refer the bill back to committee to allow the MOU system to work over the course of another year before further consideration.
