HB 435 clarifies that the “practice of engineering” for purposes of the regulation of professional engineers does not include any professional service or creative work performed in the fields of information technology, information security, electronics, digital systems, or computing. The committee heard testimony that this language would be disruptive and confusing to the profession and therefore finds it inexpedient to legislate.
