This bill provides that no childhood immunization requirement shall require a vaccine that has not been shown in clinical trials to prevent transmission of any disease. Vaccines are tested in clinical trial for safety and efficacy, while prevention of transmission may be observed over time. Because this may impact the availability of new vaccinations and affect vaccines currently on the childhood schedule, the Committee does not feel it is best to move forward with this legislation.
