At the request of the Liquor Commission, this bill would enable the holder of a brew pub license to hold an on-premises or off-premises license under certain conditions. There are individuals who currently own multiple restaurant locations, and they would like to distribute their beer to them. Under this bill, a brew pub licensee could self-distribute to no more than one on-premises license owned by themselves. A licensee could not hold any other type of manufacturing license.
