House Bill 584-FN proclaims that the World Health Organization, United Nations, and World Economic Forum shall have no jurisdiction in the State of New Hampshire and provides that no policies may be implemented from the identified organizations by any public, or quasi-public entity in the State. Given that the identified organizations do not create policy for the State of New Hampshire nor its entities, the committee does not recommend the bill for passage.
