HOUSE BILL **664-A**

AN ACT relative to childhood immunization requirements.

SPONSORS: Rep. Polozov, Merr. 10

COMMITTEE: Health, Human Services and Elderly Affairs

ANALYSIS

This bill provides that childhood immunization requirements shall not require a vaccine that has not been tested with an inert placebo in clinical trials.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Childhood Immunization Requirements. Amend RSA 141-C:20-a by inserting
2 after paragraph III the following new paragraph:

3 IV. Nothing in this section shall require a vaccine that has not been tested with an inert
4 placebo in a clinical trial.

5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
