**SB 106-FN**, relative to the participation of customer generators in net energy metering.

Ought to Pass with Amendment, Vote 5-0.

Senator David Watters for the committee.

SB 106-FN seeks to require large customer-generators to consume at least 33% of their own electricity generation for generators between one and five megawatts, while exempting low and moderate-income customers. The original language of SB 106 was amended to address concerns from solar investors and developers regarding the effective date and potential financial harm to existing projects. The bill will reduce energy costs, enhance reliability, and encourage investment.
