ANALYSIS

This bill makes an appropriation of \$1,000,000 to the department of education to fund the online tutoring program, Tutor.com.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT making an appropriation to the department of education to fund the online tutoring program.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Appropriation; Department of Education. The sum of \$1,000,000 for the biennium ending
2 June 30, 2027 is hereby appropriated to the department of education to continue the state's online
3 tutoring program, Tutor.com. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for said sum out of any
4 money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated. These funds shall be non-lapsing.

5 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.

METHODOLOGY:

This bill provides a \$1,000,000 general fund appropriation for the biennium ending June 30, 2027, to the Department of Education to continue the state's online tutoring program (Tutor.com). The Department states the current contract with the Princeton Review for Tutor.com is \$1,600,000 per year, therefore, funding in this bill is insufficient by \$1,100,000 in each FY 2026 and FY 2027 (\$2,200,000 total).
