House Bill 221 as amended defines “advanced nuclear resource” (ANR) and includes ANR options alongside renewable energy for utility services, establishes investment limits for distributed generation, clarifies the nuclear development coordinator’s duties, authorizes multi-year energy RFPs with regional coordination, expands community solar capacity (including doubling the low-moderate income cap from 6 MW to 12 MW), and permits group net metering members to contract with multiple hosts within their total load.
