10 department head of the institutions and departments referred to herein; provided that all contracts
11 and projects and plans and specifications therefor shall be awarded in accordance with the
12 provisions of RSA 21-I and RSA 228.

13 4 Expenditures; Community College System of New Hampshire.

14 I. The appropriations made for the community college system in paragraph II of section 1
15 and the sums available for this project shall be expended by the trustees of the community college
16 system of New Hampshire.

17 II. The appropriations made to the community college system in paragraph II of section 1
18 are available for all costs incidental to the completion of the project enumerated including but not
19 limited to the costs of the services for architects, engineers, and other consultants of such kind and
20 capacity as the community college system board of trustees may, in its discretion, wish to employ on
21 such terms and conditions as the board determines. These monies shall be spent under the direction
22 of the community college system board of trustees and pursuant to the policies adopted by the board
23 of trustees.

24 III. Any authorization contained in this act which is at variance with the requirements of
25 applicable federal law and regulations shall be controlled by the terms of federal law and
26 regulations.

27 5 Expenditures; University System of New Hampshire.

28 I. The appropriations made for the university system in paragraph XV of section 1 and the
29 sums available for these projects shall be expended by the trustees of the university system of New
30 Hampshire.

31 II. The appropriations made to the university system in paragraph XV of section 1 are
32 available for all costs incidental to the completion of the projects enumerated including but not
33 limited to the costs of the services for architects, engineers, and other consultants of such kind and
34 capacity as the university system board of trustees may, in its discretion, wish to employ on such
35 terms and conditions as the board determines. These monies shall be spent under the direction of
36 the university system board of trustees and pursuant to the policies adopted by the board of trustees.

1 III. Any authorization contained in this act which is at variance with the requirements of
2 applicable federal law and regulations shall be controlled by the terms of federal law and
3 regulations.

4 6 Land Acquisition. Any land acquired under the appropriations made in sections 1 and 2 of
5 this act, if any, as may be acquired under the appropriation shall be purchased by the commissioner
6 of the department of administrative services or the department of transportation with the approval
7 of governor and council.

8 7 Bonds Authorized.

9 I. To provide funds for the total of the appropriations of state funds made in sections 1 and 2
10 of this act, the state treasurer is hereby authorized to borrow upon the credit of the state not
11 exceeding the sum of \$170,163,276 and for said purposes may issue bonds and notes in the names
12 and on behalf of the state of New Hampshire in accordance with the provisions of RSA 6-A. The
13 source of funds are as follows: General Fund \$143,434,276, Highway Funds \$4,650,000, and Other
14 Funds \$22,079,000.

15 8 Payments.

16 I. The payment of principal and interest on bonds and notes issued for the projects in section
17 1 shall be made when due from the general fund of the state.

18 II. The payment of principal and interest on bonds issued for the projects in:

19 (a) The highway fund portion of the appropriations made in section 2 shall be made from
20 the highway fund and the general fund portion from the general fund.

21 (b) The fish and game fund portion of the appropriations made in paragraph VI of
22 section 1 shall be made from the fish and game fund.

23 9 Powers of Governor and Council. The governor and council are hereby authorized and
24 empowered:

25 I. To cooperate with and enter into such agreements with the federal government, or any
26 agency thereof, as they may deem advisable, to secure federal funds for the purposes hereof.

27 II. To accept any federal funds which are, or become available for any project under sections
28 1 and 2 beyond the estimated amounts. The net appropriation of state funds for any project for
29 which such additional federal funds are accepted shall be reduced by the amount of such additional
30 funds, and the amount of bonding authorized by section 7 shall be reduced by the same amount.

31 10 Transfers. The individual project appropriations provided in sections 1 and 2 of this act shall
32 not be transferred or expended for any other purposes; provided that if there is a balance remaining
33 after an individual project, which is fully funded by state funds, is completed, accepted, and final
34 payment made, said balance or any part thereof may be transferred by governor and council, to any
35 other individual project or projects, which are also fully funded by state funds, within the same
36 section and from the same funding source, provided that prior approval or the capital project
37 overview committee is obtained.

2 for any project provided for by sections 1 and 2 is determined on the basis of an estimate of
3 anticipated federal, local, or other funds, and if the amount of such funds actually received or

5 appropriation of state funds thereof shall be reduced by the same proportion as the proportion by
6 which federal, local, or other funds are reduced. The amount of bonding authorized by section 7
7 shall be reduced by the amount that the appropriation of state funds is reduced pursuant to this
8 section.

9 12 Division of Public Works Design and Construction Inspection Services; Davis-Bacon Act
10 Compliance. The appropriations for those projects which are managed by the division of public
11 works design and construction, Department of Administrative Services, may be expended to fund
12 temporary personnel for the purpose of providing construction inspection services and Davis-Bacon
