

Amendment to HB 1655-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 AN ACT relative to the municipal registration fee for an agricultural/industrial utility
4 vehicle.
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6 Amend RSA 261:153, I as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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8 I. The treasurer of each city, or such other person as the city government may designate,
9 and the town clerk of each town shall collect fees for such permits as follows: on each vehicle offered
10 for registration a sum equal to 18 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for a current model
11 year vehicle, 15 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for the first preceding model year
12 vehicle, 12 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for the second preceding model year vehicle,
13 9 mills on each dollar of the maker's list price for the third preceding model year vehicle, 6 mills on
14 each dollar of the maker's list price for the fourth preceding model year vehicle, and 3 mills on each
15 dollar of the maker's list price for the fifth preceding model year vehicle and any model year prior
16 thereto. In no event, however, shall the fee be less than \$5. Registration permit fees for
17 construction equipment, as defined in RSA 259:42, shall be governed by RSA 261:64. The director
18 shall make the final determination of any vehicle model year in any case in which a dispute arises.
19 The fee collected hereunder for a vehicle used only in the manner and for the purposes specified in
20 RSA 261:82 ***and for an agricultural/industrial utility vehicle, as defined in RSA 259:2-a,***
21 shall be \$5; and provided further, that the fee collected hereunder for a farm tractor shall be \$5. In
22 cases of doubt, the director may investigate for the purpose of determining eligibility for limited
23 purpose registrations.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill establishes the municipal registration fee for an agricultural/industrial utility vehicle.
