

Amendment to HB 1105

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT establishing a committee to study third party mortgage processors and relative
4 to an exemption from certain employment laws for certain minors.

6 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

8 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study third party mortgage
9 processors.

10 2 Membership and Compensation.

11 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

12 (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
13 of representatives.

14 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

15 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
16 the duties of the committee.

17 3 Duties. The committee shall study third party mortgage processors.

18 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
19 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house
20 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
21 section.

22 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
23 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
24 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2016.

25 6 Youth Employment Law; Prohibitions. Amend RSA 276-A:4, VII to read as follows:

26 VII. No youth 16 or 17 years of age who is duly enrolled in school shall work for more than
27 6 consecutive days or 48 hours in any one week during school vacations, including summer
28 vacation. For purposes of this paragraph, "summer vacation" means June 1 through Labor Day.
29 ***This prohibition shall not apply to youths 17 years of age who reside and work at a***
30 ***summer camp for minors.***

31 7 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill establishes a committee to study third party mortgage processors.

This bill also provides an exemption from certain youth employment laws for 17 year olds who reside and work at summer camps for minors.
