

Amendment to SB 533-FN-A-LOCAL

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 AN ACT relative to the governor's commission on alcohol and drug abuse prevention,
4 treatment, and recovery and making supplemental appropriations to the
5 commission, the department of justice, and the New Hampshire housing finance
6 authority.
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8 Amend the bill by replacing section 10 with the following:

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10 10 Supplemental Appropriation for Governor's Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse
11 Prevention, Treatment, and Recovery; Supplemental Appropriation for Supportive Housing Projects
12 for Persons with Substance Abuse Disorders.

13 I. In addition to any other sums appropriated for fiscal year 2017, \$3,000,000 for the fiscal
14 year ending June 30, 2017 is hereby appropriated to the governor's commission on alcohol and drug
15 abuse prevention, treatment and recovery for the purpose of contracts for program services, within
16 the department of health and human services. Additionally, \$2,000,000 for the fiscal year ending
17 June 30, 2017 is hereby appropriated to the New Hampshire housing finance authority for the
18 purposes set forth in RSA 204-C:56 through RSA 204-C:62, relative to the affordable housing fund,
19 provided the appropriated funds are used for the purpose of funding supportive housing projects for
20 persons with substance abuse disorders. The New Hampshire housing finance authority shall
21 prepare a report on the status of projects funded, in whole or in part, by this appropriation to be
22 delivered to the house health and human services and elderly affairs committee by December 31,
23 2017 and annually thereafter until the appropriated funds have been fully allocated.

24 II. For the purposes of funding the appropriation made in paragraph I, the governor shall
25 identify excess appropriations from sums appropriated pursuant to 2015, 275 and 276, and shall
26 transfer said sums to the appropriate class lines. Any transfers made pursuant to this section shall
27 not require the prior approval of the fiscal committee of the general court and the governor and
28 council and shall not be subject to the provisions of RSA 9:16-a, 9:17-a, and RSA 9:17-c.

29 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 11 with the following:

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31 12 Health and Human Services; Prevention Services Appropriations. Amend 2015, 275:1,
32 accounting unit 05-95-49-491510-2988 by inserting a class note immediately following such
33 accounting unit as follows:

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1 CLASS NOTE

2 102 F. This appropriation shall not lapse until June 30, 2017.

3 13 Health and Human Services; Clinical Services Appropriations. Amend 2015, 275:1,
4 accounting unit 05-95-49-491510-2990 by inserting a class note immediately following such
5 accounting unit as follows:

6 CLASS NOTE

7 102 F. This appropriation shall not lapse until June 30, 2017.

8 14 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill makes changes in the membership, organization, duties, meetings, and reports of the governor's commission on alcohol and drug abuse prevention, treatment, and recovery, and establishes that the commission serves in an advisory capacity to both the governor and the general court.

The bill also makes supplemental appropriations to the commission, the department of justice, and the New Hampshire housing finance authority.
