Amendment to SB 488-FN-LOCAL

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT establishing an advisory council on lactation.

5 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

7 1 New Subdivision; Advisory Council on Lactation. Amend RSA 275 by inserting after section
8 75 the following new subdivision:

9 Advisory Council on Lactation

10 275:76 Advisory Council on Lactation.

11 I. There is hereby established an advisory council on lactation. The advisory council shall
12 consider the goals of the United States Surgeon General and the United States Breastfeeding
13 Committee. The advisory council shall be comprised of, but not limited to:

14 (a) One member of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
15 of representatives.

16 (b) One member of the senate, appointed by the senate president.

17 (c) The commissioner of the department of labor, or designee.

18 (d) A representative from the women, infants, and children program (WIC), appointed
19 by the commissioner of the department of health and human services.

20 (e) A certified midwife, appointed by the midwifery council established in RSA 326-D:3.

21 (f) A member of the New Hampshire Business and Industry Association, appointed by
22 the association.

23 (g) The president of the New Hampshire Breastfeeding Rights Coalition, or designee.

24 (h) The chairperson of the New Hampshire Breastfeeding Task Force, or designee.

25 (i) A hospital administrator from a certified baby-friendly hospital, appointed by the
26 governor.

27 (j) A transportation representative, appointed by the governor.

28 (k) A currently breastfeeding mother, appointed by the governor.

29 (l) An attorney with experience in human rights issues, appointed by the
30 New Hampshire commission on human rights.

31 II. The advisory council may examine best practices in New Hampshire, including but not

1 limited to the Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative, Family and Sick Leave, Childcare Trainings on
2 Breastfeeding, Milk Banks, Lactation Spaces in Public Accommodations, and the World Health
3 Organization's International Code of Marketing of Breastmilk Substitutes.

4 III. Legislative members shall receive mileage at the legislative rate while attending to the
5 duties of the commission.

6 IV. The advisory council may meet as often as necessary to effectuate its goals and
7 meetings may be held by conference call. A minimum of 3 meetings per year shall be open to the
8 public.

9 V. The advisory council shall make an interim report commencing on November 1, 2016
10 and a final report on December 1, 2017 on its activities and findings, together with any
11 recommendations for proposed legislation, to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of
12 representatives, and the governor.

13 2 Repeal. RSA 275:76, relative to an advisory council on lactation, is repealed.

14 3 Effective Date.

15 I. Section 2 of this act shall take effect December 1, 2017.

16 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
