Amendment to SB 406-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 AN ACT relative to classification of certain state employee positions and relative to the
4 purchase of full body scanners for state and county correctional facilities, and
5 making appropriations therefor.

6 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 2 with the following:

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8 3 Appropriation; Department of Corrections; Scanners for State Correctional Facilities. In
9 addition to any other funds appropriated to the department of corrections, the sum of \$1,500,000 for
10 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 is hereby appropriated to the department for the purchase and
11 installation of 6 full body security scanners in the state correctional facilities. Three of the scanners
12 shall be installed in the state prison for men in Concord, 2 scanners shall be installed in the
13 northern New Hampshire correctional facility in Berlin, and one scanner shall be installed in the
14 new state prison for women. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for said sum out of any
15 money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

16 4 Appropriation; Department of Justice; Scanners for County Correctional Facilities. In
17 addition to any other funds appropriated to the department of justice, the sum of \$1,000,000 for the
18 fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 is hereby appropriated to the department for the purpose of
19 providing grants to the counties for up to 50 percent of the cost of one full body scanner for each
20 county correctional facility in New Hampshire that does not have such a scanner as of the effective
21 date of this act. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for said sum out of any money in the
22 treasury not otherwise appropriated.

23 5 Effective Date.

24 I. Sections 3 and 4 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2016.

25 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill:

I. Adds the following positions to the unclassified salary schedule: administrator of the site evaluation committee, deputy commissioner of the liquor commission, deputy commissioner of the department of information technology, and executive director of the office of professional licensure and certification. The bill also changes the salary classification of the chairman of the liquor commission, executive assistant to the adult parole board, chief information security officer, commandant of the state veterans home, the deputy director of the division of motor vehicles, and the executive director of the judicial council.

II. Makes an appropriation to the department of corrections to purchase 6 full body scanners for use in state correctional facilities and to the department of justice to administer grants to counties to offset a portion of the cost of full body scanners for county correctional facilities.
