

Amendment to HB 170

1 Amend the bill by replacing section 1 with the following:

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3 1 New Paragraph; Right-to-Know; Meetings Open to the Public. Amend RSA 91-A:2 by
4 inserting after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

5 II-a. If a public body maintains an Internet website or contracts with a third party to
6 maintain an Internet website on its behalf, it shall either post its approved minutes in a consistent
7 and reasonably accessible location on the website or post and maintain a notice on the website
8 stating where the minutes may be reviewed and copies requested.

9 (b) If a public body chooses to post meeting notices on the body's Internet website, it
10 shall do so in a consistent and reasonably accessible location on the website. If it does not post
11 notices on the website, it shall post and maintain a notice on the website stating where meeting
12 notices are posted.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill clarifies the procedure for posting minutes and meeting notices on the public body's Internet website.
