

Committee of Conference Report on HB 131, relative to the costs for notice of changes in a zoning district.

1 Recommendation:

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3 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the Senate amendment, and
4 concur with the Senate amendment, and

5 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
6 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

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8 Amend RSA 675:7, I-b as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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10 *I-b. In the case of a petitioned zoning amendment as authorized in RSA 675:4, the*
11 *petitioners shall be responsible for the cost of notice by mail under paragraph I-a. If the*
12 *full cost of notice is not paid at the time of submission, the municipality shall inform the*
13 *voter whose name appears first on the petition of the cost of notice within 5 business days,*
14 *and the balance shall be paid within another 5 business days. If full payment is not made*
15 *and received within 5 business days, the selectmen or village district commissioners may,*
16 *in their discretion, decide to accept or decline the petition for submission. Failure by the*
17 *municipality to inform the responsible person of the cost of notice shall be deemed a*
18 *waiver of the payment requirement.*
