

Amendment to SB 450-FN-A

1 Amend RSA 149-Q:2 as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 149-Q:2 Membership and Compensation. The members of the commission shall be as follows:

4 I. One member of an affected nuclear facility, appointed by the governor.

5 II. Two members of the Business and Industry Association, appointed by the association.

6 III. One member representing both the New Hampshire Rivers Council and New
7 Hampshire Lakes Association, appointed by those organizations.

8 IV. Three geographically dispersed members representing affected water and sewer
9 facilities appointed by the New Hampshire Municipal Association.

10 V. One member of the Granite State Hydropower Association, appointed by that
11 association.

12 VI. One member of the New Hampshire Association of Realtors, appointed by that
13 association.

14 VII. One member of the Associated General Contractors of New Hampshire, appointed by
15 that association.

16 VIII. One member of the New Hampshire Water Pollution Control Association, appointed
17 by that association.

18 IX. One member representing affected public utilities, appointed by the governor.

19 X. One member representing an affected regional planning commission, appointed by the
20 Association of New Hampshire Regional Planning Commissions.

21 XI. The commissioner of the department of transportation, or designee.

22 XII. One member of an environmental group, appointed by the governor.

24 Amend RSA 149-Q:4 as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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26 149-Q:4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study commission shall elect a chairperson
27 from among the members. The first meeting of the commission shall be called by the first-named
28 senate member. The first meeting of the commission shall be held within 45 days of the effective
29 date of this section. Seven members of the commission shall constitute a quorum.

31 Amend the bill by replacing section 2 with the following:

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1 2 Appropriation. The sum of \$350,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 is hereby
2 appropriated to the commissioner of the department of environmental services for the purposes of
3 hiring a consultant to assist the department and the NPDES advisory commission in proposing the
4 report required by RSA 149-Q:5. The governor is hereby authorized to draw a warrant for said sum
5 out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
