

Amendment to HB 1682-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 AN ACT establishing a committee to study the pervasiveness of foreclosure practices that
4 violate state or federal law.

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6 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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8 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study the pervasiveness of
9 foreclosure practices that violate state or federal law.

10 2 Membership and Compensation.

11 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

12 (a) Four members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
13 of representatives.

14 (b) Two members of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

15 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
16 the duties of the committee.

17 3 Duties. The committee shall study the pervasiveness of foreclosure practices that violate
18 state or federal law.

19 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
20 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named house
21 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
22 section. Four members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

23 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
24 legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the house
25 clerk, the senate clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2018.

26 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
