

1 Committee of Conference Report on HB 1415-FN-A, establishing a death benefit for a school
2 employee killed in the line of duty.

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4 Recommendation:

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6 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the Senate amendment, and

7 That the Senate recede from its position in adopting its amendment to the bill, and

8 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
9 House, and pass the bill as so amended:

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11 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 1 with the following:

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13 2 Appropriation; Public School Infrastructure Fund; School Emergency Readiness Program. To
14 improve security in public schools, the sum of \$10,000,000 for the biennium ending June 30, 2019 is
15 hereby appropriated the public school infrastructure fund established in RSA 198:15-y to provide
16 additional funding to the department of safety, division of homeland security and emergency
17 management's school emergency readiness program. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant
18 for said sum out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

19 3 Effective Date.

20 I. Section 1 of this act shall take effect January 1, 2019.

21 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
