

Amendment to HB 727-FN-A

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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3 1 Mount Sunapee State Park Beach; Boat Ramp and Parking Improvements; Bonded
4 Appropriation to the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources; Paid From General Funds.

5 I. The sum of \$500,000 is hereby appropriated to department of natural and cultural
6 resources, division of parks and recreations, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for the purpose
7 of creating additional parking and improving the boat ramp at Mount Sunapee state park beach.

8 II. To provide funds for the appropriation made in paragraph I, the state treasurer is
9 hereby authorized to borrow upon the credit of the state not exceeding the sum of \$500,000 and for
10 said purpose may issue bonds and notes in the name of and on behalf of the state of New Hampshire
11 in accordance with RSA 6-A. Payments of principal and interest of the bonds and notes shall be
12 made from the general fund of the state.

13 2 Mount Sunapee State Park Beach; Boat Ramp and Parking Improvements; Bonded
14 Appropriation to the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources; Paid From Statewide Public
15 Boat Access Fund.

16 I. The sum of \$500,000 is hereby appropriated to department of natural and cultural
17 resources, division of parks and recreations, for the biennium ending June 30, 2021, for the purpose
18 of creating additional parking and improving the boat ramp at Mount Sunapee state park beach.

19 II. To provide funds for the appropriation made in paragraph I, the state treasurer is
20 hereby authorized to borrow upon the credit of the state not exceeding the sum of \$500,000 and for
21 said purpose may issue bonds and notes in the name of and on behalf of the state of New Hampshire
22 in accordance with RSA 6-A. Payments of principal and interest of the bonds and notes shall be
23 made from the statewide public boat access fund established in RSA 233-A:13.

24 3 Mount Sunapee State Park Beach Project. The department of natural and cultural resources
25 shall be responsible for the improvements to and operation of the boat ramp and parking at Mount
26 Sunapee state park beach. The department of natural and cultural resources, on behalf of the state,
27 may accept donations designated for the Mount Sunapee state park beach project and shall use such
28 donations to offset project costs. The improved boat ramp shall be deemed to be a public boat access
29 area as defined in RSA 233-A:1, IV.

30 4 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill makes 2 bonded appropriations to the department of natural and cultural resources for boat ramp and parking improvements at Mount Sunapee state park beach, one of which shall be paid from the public boat access fund.
