

Amendment to HB 520

1 Amend RSA 155:39-e, I as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 I. This section applies to any new building or facility proposed to be constructed specifically
4 as a place of public accommodation on or after January 1, 2021. This section also applies to any
5 single renovation of an existing building or facility which is proposed to be constructed on or after
6 January 1, 2021, if the cost of such renovation exceeds \$50,000.

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8 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 1 with the following:

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10 2 Repeal. RSA 155:39-e, relative to diaper changing stations in places of public accommodation,
11 is repealed.

12 3 Contingency. Section 2 of this act shall take effect on the date that the chairperson of the
13 building code review board certifies to the director of the office of legislative services that, pursuant
14 to RSA 155-A:10, V, the state building code review board has adopted, and the legislature has
15 ratified, a rule to amend the state building code that incorporates the requirements of RSA 155:39-e.
16 If the board does not adopt such a rule, or such a rule is not ratified by the legislature, section 2 of
17 this act shall not take effect.

18 4 Effective Date.

19 I. Section 2 of this act shall take effect as provided in section 3 of this act.

20 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

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AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill requires certain places of public accommodation to install and maintain at least one diaper changing station that is accessible to all genders when the facility is open to the public. The bill includes a contingent repeal of the statutory requirement if the building code review board includes the requirement in the state building code.
