

Amendment to HB 1280-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing sections 1-4 with the following:

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3 1 Accident and Health Insurance; Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies; Individual.
4 Amend RSA 415:6-e to read as follows:

5 415:6-e Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies. Each insurer that issues or renews any
6 individual policy, plan, or contract of accident or health insurance providing benefits for medical or
7 hospital expenses, shall provide to certificate holders of such insurance, who are residents of this
8 state, coverage for medically appropriate and necessary outpatient self-management training and
9 educational services, pursuant to a written order of a primary care physician or practitioner,
10 including but not limited to medical nutrition therapy for the treatment of diabetes, provided by a
11 certified, registered, or licensed health care professional with expertise in diabetes, subject to the
12 terms and conditions of the policy. Each insurer that issues or renews any individual policy, plan, or
13 contract of accident or health insurance providing benefits for medical or hospital expenses which
14 provides a prescription rider shall cover medically appropriate or necessary insulin, oral agents, and
15 equipment used to treat diabetes subject to the terms and conditions of the policy. ***An insurer that***
16 ***provides coverage for prescription insulin drugs shall cap the total amount that a covered***
17 ***person is required to pay for covered prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed***
18 ***\$100 for a 30-day supply of insulin drugs, regardless of the amount, type, or number of***
19 ***insulins needed. Coverage for prescription insulin drugs shall not be subject to any***
20 ***deductible.*** Each insurer that issues or renews any individual policy, plan, or contract of accident
21 or health insurance providing benefits for medical or hospital expenses which provides for durable
22 medical equipment coverage shall provide coverage for medically appropriate or necessary
23 equipment used to treat diabetes subject to the terms and conditions of the policy.

24 2 Accident and Health Insurance; Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies; Group. Amend
25 RSA 415:18-f to read as follows:

26 415:18-f Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies. Each insurer that issues or renews any
27 policy, plan, or contract of group accident or health insurance providing benefits for medical or
28 hospital expenses, shall provide each group, or to the portion of each group comprised of certificate
29 holders of such insurance who are residents of this state, coverage for medically appropriate and
30 necessary outpatient self-management training and educational services, pursuant to a written
31 order of a primary care physician or practitioner, including but not limited to medical nutrition

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1 therapy for the treatment of diabetes, provided by a certified, registered, or licensed health care
2 professional with expertise in diabetes, subject to the terms and conditions of the policy. Each
3 insurer that issues or renews any group policy, plan, or contract of accident or health insurance
4 providing benefits for medical or hospital expenses which provides a prescription rider shall cover
5 medically appropriate or necessary insulin, oral agents, and equipment used to treat diabetes subject
6 to the terms and conditions of the policy. ***An insurer that provides coverage for prescription***
7 ***insulin drugs shall cap the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for***
8 ***covered prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed \$100 for a 30-day supply of***
9 ***insulin drugs, regardless of the amount, type, or number of insulins needed. Coverage for***
10 ***prescription insulin drugs shall not be subject to any deductible.*** Each insurer that issues or
11 renews any group policy, plan, or contract of accident or health insurance providing benefits for
12 medical or hospital expenses which provides for durable medical equipment coverage shall provide
13 coverage for medically appropriate or necessary equipment used to treat diabetes subject to the
14 terms and conditions of the policy.

15 3 Health Service Corporations; Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies. Amend RSA 420-
16 A:17-a to read as follows:

17 420-A:17-a Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies. Every health service corporation and
18 every similar corporation licensed under the laws of another state that issues or renews any policy,
19 plan, or contract of individual or group accident or health insurance providing benefits for medical or
20 hospital expenses, shall provide to each individual or group, or to the portion of each group
21 comprised of certificate holders of such insurance who are residents of this state, coverage for the
22 medically appropriate and necessary outpatient self-management training and educational services,
23 pursuant to a written order of a primary care physician or practitioner, including but not limited to
24 medical nutrition therapy for the treatment of diabetes, provided by a certified, registered, or
25 licensed health care professional with expertise in diabetes, subject to the terms and conditions of
26 the policy. Each health service corporation that issues or renews any individual or group policy,
27 plan, or contract of accident or health insurance providing benefits for medical or hospital expenses
28 which provides a prescription rider shall cover medically appropriate or necessary insulin, oral
29 agents, and equipment used to treat diabetes subject to the terms and conditions of the policy. ***Each***
30 ***health service corporation that provides coverage for prescription insulin drugs shall cap***

3 4 Health Maintenance Organizations; Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies. Amend
4 RSA 420-B:8-k to read as follows:

5 420-B:8-k Coverage for Diabetes Services and Supplies. Every health maintenance organization
6 and every similar corporation licensed under the laws of another state that issues or renews any
7 policy, plan, or contract of individual or group health insurance providing benefits for medical or
8 hospital expenses, shall provide to each individual or group, or to the portion of each group
9 comprised of certificate holders of such insurance who are residents of this state, coverage for the
10 medically appropriate and necessary outpatient self-management training and educational services,
11 pursuant to a written order of a primary care physician or practitioner, including but not limited to
12 medical nutrition therapy for the treatment of diabetes, provided by a certified, registered, or
13 licensed health care professional with expertise in diabetes, subject to the terms and conditions of
14 the policy. Each health maintenance organization that issues or renews any individual or group
15 policy, plan, or contract of accident or health insurance providing benefits for medical or hospital
