

Amendment to HB 1224-FN-A-LOCAL

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

2
3 1 Appropriation; Lakeshore Redevelopment Planning Commission. There is hereby
4 appropriated to the lakeshore redevelopment planning commission established in RSA 10:5, the sum
5 of \$500,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, which shall be nonlapsing and shall be
6 expended solely for the purpose of obtaining matching funds for supporting the operations of the
7 commission and not for any other purpose. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for said
8 sum out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

9 2 Lakeshore Redevelopment Planning Commission; Authorization to Accept Funds. Amend RSA
10 10:8, II(a) to read as follows:

11 (a) Request, accept, and expend any **state or** federal funds available to the commission
12 to carry out the purposes of this subdivision or the duties of the commission[~~provided that state~~
13 ~~funds available to be expended by the commission shall not exceed \$365,000 in capital and general~~
14 ~~fund appropriations~~].

15 3 Budget Appropriation for the Lakeshore Redevelopment Planning Commission. Amend 2019,
16 345 by amending the footnote following the appropriation in accounting unit 01-14-14-141510-3892
17 to read as follows:

18 * Funds in Accounting Unit 3892 for the Lakeshore Redevelopment Planning Commission
19 established in RSA 10:5, shall not lapse ~~[until June 30, 2021]~~ and shall be expended to support the
20 operations of the Commission **or any successor entity**.

21 4 Capital Appropriation for Lakeshore Redevelopment Planning Commission; Lapse of 2017
22 Appropriation Removed. Amend 2017, 240:3, II to read as follows:

23 II. The sum of \$115,000 is hereby appropriated to the lakeshore redevelopment planning
24 commission established under RSA 10:5 for the purpose of undertaking any required title,
25 subdivision, and other land preparation needed for the sale of the former Laconia state school
26 property and training center property, and for the purpose of employing a consultant with real estate
27 or financial expertise in preparation of the request for proposals for the sale of said property. Said
28 funds shall not lapse ~~[until June 30, 2021]~~.

29 5 Transfer of Prior Appropriations to Successor Entity. Any appropriation to the lakeshore
30 redevelopment planning commission established pursuant to RSA 10:5, including but not limited to
31 appropriations to the commission in 2017, 240, 2019, 345, and section 1 of this act, shall be

1 transferred to, and available for expenditure by, any successor entity or authority on the date of such
2 transfer.

3 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill makes an appropriation to the lakeshore redevelopment planning commission, removes the lapse of prior appropriations to the commission, and provides for transfer of such appropriations to any successor entity.
