

Floor Amendment to SB 680-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT relative to materials used in the construction or repair of state roads and
4 establishing a committee to study issues relating to paving New Hampshire Route
5 111 in Hampstead and Atkinson.

7 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 1 with the following:

8

9 2 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study issues relating to paving
10 New Hampshire Route 111 in Hampstead and Atkinson.

11 3 Membership and Compensation.

12 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

13 (a) Two members of the senate, one of whom shall be a member of the senate
14 transportation committee and one of whom shall represent Hampstead or Atkinson, appointed by
15 the president of the senate.

16 (b) Three members of the house of representatives, one of whom shall be a member of
17 the public works and highways committee, one of whom shall represent the town of Hampstead, and
18 one of whom shall represent the town of Atkinson, appointed by the speaker of the house of
19 representatives.

20 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
21 the duties of the committee.

22 4 Duties. The committee shall:

23 I. Review the contract approved by the governor and council, X-A004(830), 42246 concerning
24 section 19602- Atkinson-Hampstead- NH111.

25 II. Determine the causes of the cost overruns that resulted in roughly 20 percent of the
26 original paving project left uncompleted.

27 III. Determine the causes for the premature failure of the newly laid asphalt.

28 IV. Review if best practices were followed and if not why they were not followed.

29 5 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
30 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named senate
31 member. The first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this
32 section. Three members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

1 6 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
2 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
3 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2020.

4 7 Effective Date.

5 I. Section 1 of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

6 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
