

Amendment to SB 558-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT establishing a committee to study commercial insurance coverage of fertility
4 treatments and employee protections while receiving fertility treatments.

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6 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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8 1 Committee Established. There is established a committee to study commercial insurance
9 coverage of fertility treatments and employee protections while receiving fertility treatments.

10 2 Membership and Compensation.

11 I. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

12 (a) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

13 (b) Two members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the house
14 of representatives, one of whom shall serve on the health, human services, and elderly affairs
15 committee and one of whom shall serve on the labor, industrial, and rehabilitative services
16 committee.

17 II. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending to
18 the duties of the committee.

19 3 Duties. The committee shall study commercial insurance coverage of fertility treatments,
20 including for same-sex couples, and employee protections while receiving fertility treatments.

21 4 Chairperson; Quorum. The members of the study committee shall elect a chairperson from
22 among the members. The first meeting of the committee shall be called by the senate member. The
23 first meeting of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section. Two
24 members of the committee shall constitute a quorum.

25 5 Report. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
26 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
27 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2024.

28 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
