

Amendment to SB 459-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 10 with the following:

3 11 Department of Health and Human Services; Division for Children, Youth and Families;
4 Classified Positions Established; Appropriation.

5 I. The following classified positions are established in the department of health and human
6 services to support the department's division for children, youth and families, bureau of field
7 services and legal services in completing new responsibilities as a result of statute changes:

8 (a) 11 attorney II positions (labor grade 30, step 5); and

9 (b) 24 child protective service worker (CPSW) IV positions (labor grade 25, step 5).

10 II. The sum of \$1,602,216 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, is hereby appropriated to
11 the department of health and human services for the purpose of funding the positions established in
12 paragraph I. In addition to the appropriation and notwithstanding RSA 14:30-a, the department
13 may accept and expend matching federal funds without prior approval of the fiscal committee of the
14 general court. The governor is authorized to draw a warrant for the general fund portion of said sum
15 out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

16 12 Repeal. 2020, 26:56, relative to the prospective repeal of RSA 169-C:2-f on July 1, 2024, is
17 repealed.

18 13 Effective Date.

19 I. Section 12 of this act shall take effect June 30, 2024.

20 II. Section 11 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2024.

21 III. The remainder of this act shall take effect January 1, 2025.
