

Amendment to SB 433

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT establishing a committee to study the marketing of e-cigarettes and e-liquid in this
4 state, including the legality of available products, appropriate wholesale and retail
5 compliance and tax collection system of the same.

7 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

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9 1 New Section; Liquor Licenses and Fees; Committee to Study the Marketing of E-cigarettes
10 and E-liquid. Amend RSA 178 by inserting after section 31 the following new section:

11 178:32 Committee to Study the Marketing of E-cigarettes and E-liquid.

12 I. There is established a committee to study the marketing of e-cigarettes and e-liquid in
13 this state, including the legality of available products, appropriate wholesale and retail compliance
14 and tax collection system of the same.

15 II. The members of the committee shall be as follows:

16 (a) One member of the senate, appointed by the president of the senate.

17 (b) Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the speaker of the
18 house of representatives.

19 III. Members of the committee shall receive mileage at the legislative rate when attending
20 to the duties of the committee.

21 IV. The committee shall study the marketing of e-cigarettes and e-liquid in this state,
22 including the legality of available products, appropriate wholesale and retail compliance and tax
23 collection systems for such products. The committee shall focus on the sales, marketing,
24 enforcement, and tax collection mechanisms of e-cigarettes and e-liquid pursuant to retail tobacco
25 licensing set forth in RSA 178:19-a. The committee shall consult with the Department of Revenue
26 Administration and the Liquor Commission as well as stakeholders in the private sector.

27 V. The members of the committee shall elect a chairperson from among the members. The
28 first meeting of the committee shall be called by the first-named senate member. The first meeting
29 of the committee shall be held within 45 days of the effective date of this section. Three members of
30 the committee shall constitute a quorum.

31 VI. The committee shall report its findings and any recommendations for proposed
32 legislation to the president of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the senate
33 clerk, the house clerk, the governor, and the state library on or before November 1, 2024.
