Amendment to HB 379

1 Amend RSA 276-A:4, VI as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 1 Youth Employment Law; Prohibitions. Amend RSA 276-A:4, VI and VII to read as follows:

4 VI. ~~[In any employer's predetermined designated work week during which school is in~~  
5 ~~session for 5 days]~~ ***Between the date on which the school year begins and the date the school***  
6 ***year ends***, no youth 16 or 17 years of age who is duly enrolled in school shall work more than 35  
7 hours ~~[during that work week]~~ ***in a standard Monday through Friday week other than the***  
8 ***school's vacation weeks.***

10 Amend RSA 276-A:13-a as inserted by section 2 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

12 276-A:13-a Night Work. In addition to the provisions of RSA 276-A:4, during the period in  
13 which school is in session, no youth 16 or 17 years of age who is duly enrolled in school shall be  
14 permitted to work later than 9:00 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday unless their school is closed on  
15 Monday or Friday for a holiday, or later than 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday.
