

Amendment to SB 179-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT relative to the state council on housing stability.

5 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 1 with the following:

7 2 State Council on Housing Stability; Membership. RSA 4-H:2, I(i) is repealed and reenacted to  
8 read as follows:

9 (i) Two landlords, appointed by the governor.

10 3 New Subparagraph; State Council on Housing Stability; Duties. Amend RSA 4-H:3, I by  
11 inserting after subparagraph (h) the following new subparagraph:

12 (i) Compile information regarding United States Housing and Urban Development  
13 (HUD) programs administered by state and local government agencies and assist the agencies in the  
14 preparation of federally required plans and related performance reports. The council shall present  
15 such plans to the governor for approval and transmission to HUD.

16 4 State Council on Housing Stability. Amend RSA 4-H:3, II to read as follows:

17 II. The state council on housing stability shall be jointly facilitated by the department of  
18 health and human services, the department of business and economic affairs, *the New Hampshire*  
19 *housing finance authority*, and the New Hampshire community development finance authority.  
20 The first meeting of the council shall be called by the legislative member appointed by the speaker of  
21 the house of representatives pursuant to RSA 4-H:2, I(t) within 45 days of the effective date of this  
22 section.

23 ***II-a. The council may create workgroups to advise members on its duties and***  
24 ***compliance with federal laws and policies related to housing.***

25 5 Repeal. RSA 204-C:47, relative to the biennial housing plan prepared by the housing finance  
26 authority, is repealed.

27 6 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

This bill provides that the council on housing stability shall be attached to the department of health and human services. The bill also revises members and duties of the council, and repeals the requirement that the housing finance authority submit a biennial housing plan.
