12 2 Advisory Council on the Education of Children Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing; Reference
13 Deleted. Amend RSA 186-C:35, V to read as follows:

14 V. On or before November 1, the council shall submit an annual report its findings and any
15 recommendations for proposed legislation to the speaker of the house of representatives, the
16 president of the senate, the education committees in the house and senate, [~~the New Hampshire~~
17 ~~commission on deafness and hearing loss established in RSA 125-Q,~~] the house clerk, the senate
18 clerk, the governor, and the state library.

29 VII. RSA 72:8-f, relative to the study commission on the assessing of power generation.

30 VIII. RSA 105-D:2-a, relative to the commission to develop recommendations for legislation
31 to establish a single statewide entity to receive complaints alleging misconduct regarding all sworn
32 and elected law enforcement officers.
