

Amendment to HB 713-FN

1 Amend the bill by replacing all after the enacting clause with the following:

2

3 1 Installation and Maintenance of Mile Markers.

4 I. The department of transportation shall install mile markers along the length of Route  
5 112, also known as the Kancamagus Highway, from the town of Lincoln to the town of Conway and  
6 may install mile markers along Route 112 from the town of Bath to the town of Woodstock.

7 II. Generally, mile markers shall be installed at regular intervals of not greater than one  
8 mile and shall be clearly visible and legible to motorists and emergency personnel. The department  
9 of transportation may omit mile markers along densely developed segments of highway.

10 III. The department of transportation shall maintain the mile markers installed pursuant  
11 this section in accordance with, and subject to, the applicable provisions of the Federal Highway  
12 Administration's Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

13 IV. Prior to installation the department of transportation shall meet with public officials  
14 from the town of Lincoln and the town of Albany to provide information on mile marker design,  
15 proposed locations and traffic impacts.

16 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 18 months after its passage.
