

Amendment to HB 85-FN

1 Amend RSA 326-E:3-a, II as inserted by section 3 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

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3 II. A student who has obtained a temporary student license and who is employed in a
4 healthcare setting may render respiratory care services only under the direct supervision of a
5 licensed respiratory care practitioner for a period of 2 months following the date of issuance. After
6 the 2 months have expired, only general supervision by a licensed respiratory care practitioner of the
7 employed student at that healthcare setting shall be required. The scope of practice of the student
8 respiratory therapist is limited to those activities for which there is documented evidence of
9 competency and under conditions specified by rule, pursuant to RSA 541-A.
