

Floor Amendment to SB 180-FN

1 Amend the title of the bill by replacing it with the following:

3 AN ACT designating Coos county as a distressed place-based economy and relative to the
4 department of health and human services' rulemaking authority regarding
5 immunization requirements.

7 Amend the bill by replacing all after section 3 with the following:

9 4 Communicable Disease; Immunization. Amend RSA 141-C:20-a, I to read as follows:

10 I. All parents or legal guardians shall have their children, who are residing in this state,
11 immunized against ~~[certain diseases. These diseases shall include, but not be limited to,]~~
12 diphtheria, mumps, pertussis, poliomyelitis, rubella, rubeola, and tetanus. ~~[The commissioner shall~~
13 ~~adopt rules under RSA 541-A relative to other diseases which require immunization.]~~ ***The rules***
14 ***adopted by the commissioner requiring varicella, Hepatitis B, and Haemophilus influenzae***
15 ***type B (Hib) vaccinations shall remain in effect until their regular expiration date of June***
16 ***30, 2026.***

17 5 Repeal. RSA 141-C:6, XIII, relative to rulemaking for other communicable diseases under
18 RSA 141-C:20-a, I.

19 6 Effective Date.

20 I. Section 5 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2045.

21 II. The remainder of this act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill:

I. Designates Coos County as a distressed place-based economy and requires commissioners of state agencies to consult with county commissioners before making regulatory decisions that would affect Coos County.

II. Limits childhood immunization requirements to diseases identified in statute.

III. Removes the authority of the commissioner of health and human services to adopt rules requiring immunization for additional childhood diseases.
