11 2 Occupations and Professions; Dentists and Dentistry; Examinations and Licenses;  
12 Applications. Amend RSA 317-A:8, I to read as follows:

13 I. Applications for licensure ***to practice dentistry*** shall be made to the office of professional  
14 licensure and certification in writing or online and shall be accompanied by a fee established in rules  
15 adopted under RSA 541-A by the office and by satisfactory proof that the applicant is a graduate of a  
16 school that is recognized by the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) ***and holds the degree***  
17 ***of D.D.S. or D.M.D.*** The applicant shall be of good professional character and 18 years of age or  
18 older.
