

1 Committee of Conference Report on HB 273, relative to a parent's access to their minor child's
2 library records.

4 Recommendation:

5 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrency with the Senate amendment, and
6 concur with the Senate amendment, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
8 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend the bill by replacing section 1 with the following:

11

12 1 New Paragraph; Library User Records; Confidentiality; Access to Library Records of Minors.

13 Amend RSA 201-D:11 by inserting after paragraph II the following new paragraph:

14 II-a. All library records related to a minor's current borrowing of printed library materials
15 and audio-visual materials, such as DVDs and CDs, shall be available to either parent or the legal
16 guardian of the minor when requested by either parent or the legal guardian of the minor, or the
17 parent or legal guardian of the minor whose address matches that on the library account or who is
18 listed on the library account.
