AN ACT relative to reporting regarding the northern border alliance program.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Northern Border Alliance Program; Reporting Requirements. Amend RSA 21-P:69, IV to read
2 as follows:

3 IV. The program shall include semi-annual reporting, to the governor, senate president, and
4 speaker of the house of representatives, which includes measurable program results and a detailed
5 accounting of program funding and uses. ***Any grants provided to state, county, or local law***
6 ***enforcement agencies in accordance with the intentions of the program shall be reported,***
7 ***including who received such grants, when, and what the funds were used for. The number***
8 ***of personnel involved in the program as well as their rank and/title shall be included in***
9 ***the report. Any equipment or technology used and purchased through the program shall***
10 ***also be included. The report shall also include the number of persons arrested, persons***
11 ***cited, and persons subjected to a field stop or warning. The report shall also include the***
12 ***date, time, and location of Customs and Border Protection-related incidents, assists,***
13 ***intelligence received, or other activity. For persons in each of these categories, the***
14 ***aggregate data shall also include the municipality and country where each such person***
15 ***resides. For persons who are arrested or cited, the report shall also include the race of***
16 ***such persons to the extent such information is indicated on the complaint, summons, or***
17 ***citation.*** The first report shall be submitted on or before December 31, 2023.

18 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
