AN ACT relative to transferring statutory authority from the department of education to the department of military affairs and veterans services regarding educational support services.

This bill completes the transfer of authority to oversee the functions of the Veterans Education Services from the department of education to the department of military affairs and veterans services.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to transferring statutory authority from the department of education to the department of military affairs and veterans services regarding educational support services.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 1 New Paragraph; Military Affairs and Veterans Services Overseeing Education Programs.
2 Amend RSA 110-B:88 by inserting after paragraph VIII the following new paragraph:
3 IX. Oversee the functions of the Veterans Education Services as authorized by Congress.
4 The division may approve for veterans' education and services any institution licensed under RSA
5 188-G. The department of military affairs and veterans services will provide these services pursuant
6 to chapters 30, 32, 33, 34, 35, and 36 of 38 United States Code, and section 510 and chapters 1606
7 and 1607 of 10 United States Code.
8 2 Repeal. The following are repealed:
9 I. RSA 21-N:8-a, II(e)(4), relative to department of education overseeing the veterans
10 education services, is repealed.
11 II. RSA 188-G:8, relative to veterans, education, and services approval by the department of
12 education services, is repealed.
13 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
