ANALYSIS

This bill replaces the term "colt" with the more inclusive term "foal" and clarifies language related to foals separated from their dams.

AN ACT relative to the use of the term "foal" and "colt."

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Juvenile Equines. Amend RSA 644:8, III, (f) and (g) to read as follows:

2 (f) Has in his or her possession an equine [~~colt~~] **foal** that is less than 90 days old that is
3 not being nursed by its dam, unless [~~the colt was born in this state, and~~] its dam has died [~~within~~
4 ~~this state~~] before the [~~colt became~~] **foal has turned** 90 days old;

5 (g) Sells an equine [~~colt~~] **foal** that is less than 90 days old that [~~is not being nursed by~~]
6 **has been separated from** its dam; or

7 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
