AN ACT relative to reports by the department of health and human services regarding Medicaid enhancement for children and pregnant women.

AMENDED ANALYSIS

This bill requires the department of health and human services to provide quarterly reports regarding Medicaid enhancement for children and pregnant women for the biennium ending June 30, 2027 and to submit such reports annually thereafter.

Medicaid enhancement for children and pregnant women.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Medicaid Enhancement for Children and Pregnant Women; Reporting Requirement. RSA
2 167:68, IV(d) is repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

3 (d) Beginning October 1, 2025, and for the remainder of the biennium ending June 30,
4 2027, the commissioner of the department of health and human services shall submit quarterly
5 reports to the oversight committee on health and human services, the legislative committees with
6 jurisdiction over health and human services, and the governor regarding the department's
7 administration of the Medicaid enhancement for children and pregnant women for 12 months of
8 continuous coverage for the entire postpartum period. Beginning July 1, 2027, the reports shall be
9 submitted annually. The reports shall include status updates on the department's efforts in
10 reducing administrative burdens for enrollees and the department's progress to expand access and
11 participation to voluntary, evidence-based maternal home visiting programs. Reports submitted
12 under this section shall also be posted on the department's website.

13 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
