STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Five*

AN ACT            allowing the department of transportation to execute a right-of-way use agreement, subject to Federal Highway Administration approval, for snowmobile operation along Interstate 89 in the town of Sutton, from NH Route 114, traveling south for one mile.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1            1 Department of Transportation; Right-of-Use Agreement for Snowmobile Operation. The  
2 commissioner of the department of transportation may, subject to Federal Highway Administration  
3 approval, execute a right-of-way use agreement for snowmobile operation along Interstate 89 in the  
4 town of Sutton, from NH Route 114, traveling south for one mile.

5            2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
