HOUSE BILL **272**

AN ACT exempting certain agricultural practices from municipal noise regulation.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT exempting certain agricultural practices from municipal noise regulation.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Powers and Duties of Towns; Power to Make Bylaws. Amend RSA 31:39, I(n) to read as
2 follows:

3 (n) Regulating noise, except that no [~~"quiet hours"~~] ordinance or bylaw that attempts to
4 regulate noise from activities related to farms, agriculture, and farming as defined in RSA 21:34-a
5 shall be enforceable within a town. This exception shall not apply to agritourism as defined in RSA
6 21:34-a, II(b)(5).

7 2 Powers of City Councils; Bylaws and Ordinances. Amend RSA 47:17, XX to read as follows:

8 XX. No [~~"quiet hours"~~] ordinance or bylaw that attempts to regulate noise from activities
9 related to farms, agriculture, and farming as defined in RSA 21:34-a shall be enforceable within a
10 city. This exception shall not apply to agritourism as defined in RSA 21:34-a, II(b)(5).

11 3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
