AN ACT naming a bridge in the city of Keene after Charles Redfern.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 36:1 City of Keene; The Charles Redfern Bridge Named. Pursuant to RSA 4:43, the alternative use
2 trail bridge over Route 101 in the city of Keene, otherwise known as South Bridge, is hereby named the
3 Charles Redfern Bridge.

4 36:2 Signage. The cost of design, construction, maintenance, and installation of any signage,
5 replacement signage, or other markers required under section 1 of this act shall not be a charge to the
6 state. However, the design, construction, and installation of any signage or other markers required under
7 this act shall be approved by the department of transportation.

36:3 Effective Date. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
