AN ACT relative to adding eligibility for a disability placard for certain veterans.

ANALYSIS

This bill allows individuals who have received a special number plate for certain veterans under RSA 261:86 to automatically qualify for a walking disability placard based on their evaluation by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, eliminating the need for additional proof.

AN ACT relative to adding eligibility for a disability placard for certain veterans.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 New Paragraph; Number Plates; Walking Disability Plates and Placards. Amend RSA 261:88
2 by inserting after paragraph III the following new paragraph:

3 III-a. Any individual who has received a special number plate for certain veterans under
4 RSA 261:86 shall be eligible for a walking disability placard under this section due to their
5 evaluation by the United State Department of Veterans Affairs without the need for additional proof.

6 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
