SENATE BILL **68**

AN ACT adding a member to the governor's commission on disability.

SPONSORS: Sen. Lang, Dist 2; Sen. Pearl, Dist 17

COMMITTEE: Executive Departments and Administration

ANALYSIS

This bill adds the coordinator of the program for the deaf and hard of hearing as an ex officio member on the governor's commission on disability.

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT adding a member to the governor's commission on disability.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Governor's Commission on Disability; Ex Officio Members. Amend RSA 275-C:3
2 to read as follows:

3 275-C:3 Ex Officio Members. The following, or their designees, shall serve as ex officio members
4 without a vote on the commission: (1) the commissioner of health and human services, (2) the
5 administrator of the bureau of vocational rehabilitation, department of education, (3) the supervisor
6 of blind services, bureau of vocational rehabilitation, department of education, (4) the commissioner
7 of labor, (5) the commissioner of the department of employment security, **(6) the coordinator of the**
8 **program for the deaf and hard of hearing, bureau of vocational rehabilitation, department**
9 **of education,** and ~~[(6)]~~ **(7)** a member of the state board of education designated by the governor.

10 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
