

1 Committee of Conference Report on HB 328-FN, establishing a charitable gaming oversight
2 commission.

3
4 Recommendation:

5 That the House recede from its position of nonconcurrence with the Senate amendment, and
6 concur with the Senate amendment, and

7 That the Senate and House adopt the following new amendment to the bill as amended by the
8 Senate, and pass the bill as so amended:

10 Amend RSA 284:6-c, I-II as inserted by section 1 of the bill by replacing it with the following:

12 I. Seven voting members of the commission shall be as follows:

13 (a) The chairperson of senate ways and means committee, or their designee who is a
14 senate ways and means committee member.

15 (b) The ranking minority member of the senate ways and means committee, or their
16 designee who is a senate ways and means committee member.

17 (c) One senate member appointed by the president of the senate.

18 (d) The chairperson of house ways and means committee, or their designee who is a
19 house ways and means committee member.

20 (e) The ranking minority member of the house ways and means committee, or their
21 designee who is a house ways and means committee member.

22 (f) Two house members appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives.

23 II.(a) Nine non-voting members of the commission shall be as follows:

24 (1) Four New Hampshire citizens with no financial interest in charitable gaming and
25 no governing board responsibilities for charitable gaming entities shall be selected as follows: one
26 shall be appointed by the president of the senate; one shall be appointed by the minority leader of
27 the senate; one shall be appointed by the speaker of the house; and one shall be appointed by the
28 minority leader of the house.

29 (2) Two New Hampshire citizens shall be appointed by the governor, provided that
30 one shall be representative of gaming operators and one shall be representative of charities
31 participating in charitable gaming.

32 (3) The executive director of the lottery commission, or designee.

33 (4) The attorney general, or designee.

34 (5) One public member, appointed by the governor.

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- 1 (b) Non-voting members shall have no vote in commission matters but shall be eligible to
2 participate in all other commission proceedings.
