STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

*In the Year of Our Lord Two Thousand Twenty Five*

AN ACT                   relative to brew pub licenses.

*Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:*

1           146:1 Brew Pub; On-Premise and Off-Premise Licenses. RSA 178:13, XV is repealed and reenacted  
2 to read as follows:

3           XV. Notwithstanding the provisions of RSA 179:11, a holder of a brew pub license may hold an  
4 on-premises or off-premises license under this chapter, provided that:

5                   (a) The brew pub licensee does not hold any other type of manufacturing license under this  
6 title; and

7                   (b) Brew pub licensees holding one or more on-premises or off-premises licenses shall be  
8 limited to self- distributing to not more than one on-premises license owned by the brew pub licensee and  
9 shall not exceed 2,500 barrels of beer and/or cider during their licensing period. Nothing in this section  
10 shall authorize the holder of multiple brew pub licenses to self-distribute to more than one commonly  
11 owned on-premises or off-premises license.

146:2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
