AMENDED ANALYSIS

The bill requires school districts to email parents copies of non-academic surveys in public schools and removes the exception for the youth risk behavior survey, requiring parents to opt-in for their children to participate in this survey.

AN ACT relative to parental notice for non-academic surveys in public schools.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

1 1 Duties of State Board of Education; Administration of Non-Academic Surveys. Amend RSA 186:11,
2 IX-d to read as follows:

3 IX-d. Require School Districts to Adopt a Policy Governing the Administration of Non-academic
4 Surveys or Questionnaires to Students. The policy shall require school districts to notify a parent or legal
5 guardian of a non-academic survey or questionnaire and its purpose. The policy shall provide that no
6 student shall be required to volunteer for or submit to a non-academic survey or questionnaire, as defined
7 in this paragraph, without written consent of a parent or legal guardian unless the student is an adult or an
8 emancipated minor. ~~[The policy shall include an exception from the consent requirement for the youth risk
9 behavior survey developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The policy shall also
10 allow a parent or legal guardian to opt-out of the youth risk behavior survey developed by the Centers for
11 Disease Control and Prevention.]~~ The school district shall make such surveys or questionnaires
12 available, at the school and on the school or school district's website, for review by a student's parent or
13 legal guardian, ***and shall notify parents or legal guardians by sending such survey through email and any
14 other means of delivery the district deems appropriate*** at least 10 days prior to distribution to students. In
15 this paragraph, "non-academic survey or questionnaire" means surveys, questionnaires, or other
16 documents designed to elicit information about a student's social behavior, family life, religion, politics,
17 sexual orientation, sexual activity, drug use, or any other information not related to a student's academics.

18 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025.
